**Tools for Assembling Paper Mini's Kit**

- You may want to see the Ann's Tool Box tutorial found on the website.
- X-acto knife and fresh blade, small detailing scissors and tweezers
- Metal straight edge ruler. Press against the paper fold lines to make even and clean creases.
- A small artist's paintbrush for applying glue, small piece of aluminum foil to use as a glue pot, and a fast-grab, quick-dry craft glue. White craft glue takes too long to dry and is messy. Glue stick will work, but becomes brittle and pops loose after time.
- Metal and glass clear-dry bonding cement and toothpick to use with glue.
- Little piece of facial tissue
- A good cutting surface such as a self-heal cutting pad. You get a much better cut than with cardboard and your blade will last so much longer.

**Assembly Instructions**

**Powder Shaker**

1. Take the long strip with reproduction artwork on it and roll it tight. Use a thin paint brush handle to wrap strip around to ease the rolling operation.
2. Take the brass lid and check for size of rolled piece. Glue long edge in place to hold roll.
3. Glue paper disc to bottom of roll (optional).
4. Glue brass lid in place.
5. Hold brass bead in tweezers and carefully dip end in glue. Adhere to the top of the brass lid.

**Perfume Tray**

1. Refer to the Paper Minis website photo tutorial titled **Perfume Tray**. Cut and fold all the pieces.
2. Cut out the Tray's clear acetate insert using the included pattern.
3. Paint glue to the blank side of each of the three panels found on either **end** of the tray (the sides with the solid pink tabs). Press the inner blank sides together. **The solid pink panel is glued to the blank surface of the tray's underside.** Use a pair of tweezers to get a good thin bond.

4. Next, glue the pink tab found at each corner of the tray to the blank surface of the respective side. That forms the upright four sides. At this point it should look like an open box.
5. Paint glue to the blank surface of the two remaining sides. Press with tweezers for a thin bond. Remember that the solid pink panels will end up glued to the underside of the tray.
6. Glue the "Paper Minis" panel to the underside of the tray to give it strength.
7. Fit the acetate piece into the tray.

**Perfume Bottles**

1. Use the clear bonding glue and glue the bases to the beads. Place each on table top as you work to ensure that they are glued as upright as possible. Refer to the photo to determine which base is appropriate for each bead.
2. Take the tallest bead and glue butterfly stopper to top.
3. Spear slender pearl bead with brass pin. Glue pin inside fat clear bead as a stopper,
4. Take round pearl on pin and glue inside slender clear bead as a stopper.
5. To glue label into 'bottle' paint glue to center piece of label and wait a few seconds. Position it to the bottle and let it dry.
6. Next, paint glue to the label's long side pieces and press bond to bottle. This system makes it a little more manageable to get those labels positioned properly.

**Face Cream Jar**

1. For face cream jar, glue brass lid to large brass bead. Allow to dry.
2. Glue label to top of jar lid.
3. Follow the steps for the perfume labels and repeat steps for jar label.

**Kleenex Box**

1. Cut the oval hole at the top for the tissue before building the box.
2. Glue long side tabs to the inner blank surface of the box. Use tweezers to make good bonds.
3. Paint glue to the three smaller tabs on the bottom of the box and press flat together.
4. Paint glue to the underside of the large bottom panel and press flat against the others.
5. Cut a small square piece of facial tissue and poke into the box top opening.



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
