

**Meadow Farms Fresh Ice Cream
to Scale for 1" Dollhouses (1:12)
Prod. No. h11s005**



Required tools and supplies:

- X-acto knife and fresh blade, detailing scissors and cutting mat
- Metal straight-edge ruler to use to press against and make perfect creases
- Tweezers
- Fast-grab, quick-dry craft glue that dries clear
- A small piece of aluminum foil to use as a glue pot
- A small artist's paint brush to apply glue



Instructions:

1. Cut all pieces. Use a sharp blade tool and small detailing scissors to cut items.



2. Get a good curve on each long piece by wrapping tightly on a slender cylindrical item. In this case a slender paint brush handle is used. This keeps sharp corners from popping up during assembly.



3. Fold tabs and carton lip linings. Use the metal ruler to press against for good straight creases. See "Ann's Tool Box" tutorial to see how to make a "folding device."



4. Tabs built on a curve will be folded manually, so be careful to make fold on same plane.



5. Use a pair of tweezers to get a good clean bond. Glue the side tab of both the carton and lid cylinders. Use a good "fast-grab" craft glue.



6. Trim bottom if require beforehand. Glue the bottom onto the carton. Place glue on the circle rather than the tabs. The color side is placed upwards. This makes an uneven edge less noticeable.



7. Glue down the lip lining panels. Press firmly with tweezers in order to get a nice flat and thin edge.



8. Glue the top to the lid. Again, place the glue to the circle rather than the tabs. The lid's seam should run up the back, so position the picture accordingly.
