

Tutorial for Key Lime Pie Box for 1:12, 1:6 and 1:3 scales



Required tools and supplies:

- X-acto knife and fresh blade
- A thin metal straight-edge ruler and/or bone folder.
Make fold lines by pressing against edge of the ruler.
- Tweezers, detailing scissors
- Good cutting mat
- Fast-grab, quick-dry white craft glue that dries clear
- Small piece of aluminum foil to use as a glue pot
- Slender artist's paint brush to apply glue



1. Cut out piece and fold accordingly.



2. Note how the triangular yellow panels are folded to lay flat against box top and bottom.



3. On the smaller scale pie boxes, you may want to snip the yellow triangular panels as shown. They will lay flat this way.



4. Glue the yellow triangular panels flat as shown. Then glue box side tab.



5. Glue box openings closed.
