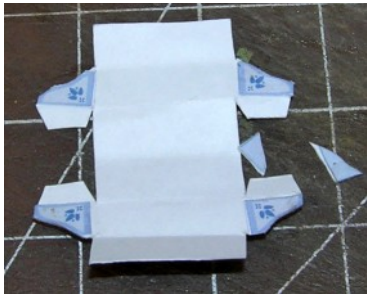


Start assembly of the quilt rack by folding as shown. Note the sides have been folded and glued blank sides together.



Trim away the blank area on the shelving sides.



Glue the shelving sides' tabs to the blank side. Do for all four tabs.



Fold down the middle so that one shelf is formed. Glue in place.



Fold back the plain blue panels and glue in place.

Use the pin to create holes for the quilt bar. There are black dots for the positioning of the bar.



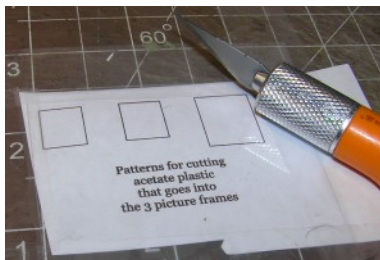
Once you have the guide holes made, slide the pin in place.



Snip the pointed end with the wire cutters.



Cut the center from the frames, then cut the frames.



Use the patterns to cut the acetate pieces to be used as faux picture glass.

Glue acetate to the back of the cut frames.



Glue the pictures to the back of the frames.





Fold photos' unit in half and use the glue stick to glue blank sides together. When dry fold again. Remember to use a straight-edge to fold against.



Remove the eraser from a mechanical pencil. Fit a paper plate between the hole left by the eraser and the eraser. Carefully press down on the eraser to emboss the plate. Repeat for all 8 remaining plates.

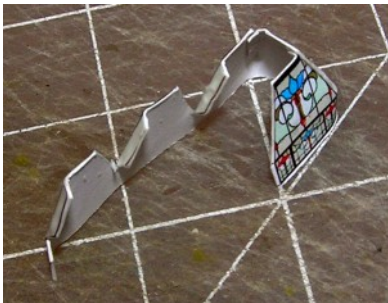


Sample embossed plate



Fold down the table sides and fold back the corner flaps.

Glue blank sides together of the corner flaps.



For stained glass shade cut, fold and glue as shown.



Thread bead with gold thread and pull through shade.



Use tweezers to help you thread gold spacer to about the 1" to 1.25". Put a dot of glue to keep it in position.

Trim thread and glue to middle of ceiling.



Create a box of the dresser. Try to keep right angles straight. Fold the mirror unit in half and glue blank sides together with glue stick. Note: the space is no longer white and you do not need to cut out space for mirror.

Tape the mirror pattern down on the mirror. Cut with the X-acto knife.



Take cut mirror piece and remove backing. Carefully position the mirror. It sticks instantly, so take care.

Now glue the dresser mirror unit to the back of the dresser.



Make perfume box.

Wind powder box to the circumference of it's lid and glue side. Next, glue lid in place

Cut the hole for the tissue exit before cutting the rest of the box. Then cut the rest. Glue to form the box. Take a tiny piece of tissue and poke down into the hole with a tool such as a tooth pick.



Valance box is simple to make as shown.



Fold up the extra panel and glue in place. that is the side that will be glued to the wall.



For valance shelf, fold back sides and glue back to back. Trim off the extra on shelf sides. Glue tabs to the underside of the unit shelf.



Glue shelf to top of valance.



Glue three plates in place.





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
