

bookorna1 ~ The Magnolias Motif Millinery Ornament Tutorial (1:12 dollhouse scale)



Required tools and supplies:

- 80mm acrylic, two-piece craft globe found on-line or at craft store.
- Find all 3-d items such as shoes, wine bottles, wine glasses etc. on-line, especially on eBay.
- Ribbon for hat box and flat toothpick for fan's handle
- Small pom pom and jewelry fittings for perfume bottle and powder puff (see photos)
- Contrasting tissue paper for gift bag
- X-acto knife and fresh blade
- A thin metal straight-edge ruler. Make fold lines by pressing against edge of the ruler.
- Scissors and tweezers
- Good cutting mat. Cardboard will ruin your blade and your project.
- Fast-grab, quick-dry white craft glue that dries clear
- An acid-free glue stick (use only when specified)
- Small piece of aluminum foil to use as a glue pot
- Slender, flat artist's paintbrush to apply glue

Products in tutorial may look different from yours, but constructed identically to yours.



Sachet Packets

1. Assemble as shown
2. Bundle them into the band and glue band.




Shopping Bag




1. Cut out all pieces. Fold handles lengthwise along fold lines--triple thick.

2. Glue the entire length of each handle so that the end result is two long, fully lined handles.




Not shown: After the handles dry, roll handles around shafted tool such as a pen or pencil. This will help you get a natural curve to your handle.

3. Take first handle and glue end to blank inner surface of the bag. See the tic marks on the printed side for handle positioning. Allow to dry.




4. Glue the other end of handle when first position has dried. Repeat these steps for other side.

5. Fold bag piece against straight edge to get nice creases. Slather a layer of glue to the long side tab. Use tweezers to press bond between tab and side of bag.




6. Place glue to two small tabs on bottom of bag. Press long non-logo panel to them.



7. Place glue to non-logo side and press logo side to it.

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




Tissue Bag Stuffer

1. Tissue panel should be approximately 12-18 times the width of the bag and 2.5 times the bag height.
2. Take tissue and fold lengthwise. make one side slightly wider than the other, unlike the photo.
3. Fan-fold length of doubled tissue.
4. Staple base of fan-fold length.
5. Separate folded halves of tissue to create fluff and volume.
6. Place tissue in bag part way.

Paneled Hat Box Tutorial

1. Cut out pieces.



2. Fold along rib lines.

3. **Don't cut the lining panels yet!** Disregard photo.

Fold along length of box tabs and along length of lid tabs. To make folds, press against a straight-edge ruler for a perfect crease.

4. Fold along the lining panels. Same as step 2.

5. Slit rib lines on lid and box lining panels.

6. Glue side tab on box to make a cylinder. Do the same for the lid. Use a quick-grab, fast-dry craft glue.

7. Glue the inside octagonal panel into the box onto the tabs at the base. Make sure it fits well before putting glue on the tabs found at the bottom.

8. Fold down and glue lining panels to interior of box. A glue stick may work more easily for you.

9. Repeat steps 7 and 8 for making the lid.

10. Glue, using craft glue, the octagonal outside disk to the bottom of the box. Repeat for the lid as well.

BOW MAKER

Required tools and supplies:

- X-acto knife and fresh blade
- Metal straight-edge ruler
- Cutting mat
- Small piece of mat board or other thick cardboard
- 4 thumb tacks
- 2 thin nails with flat heads
- Ribbon (preferably 1/16" wide)
- Heavy duty glue for glueing nails to board

1. Glue the tacks and nails as shown with heavy duty glue. The nails are about 3/4" apart. The nails do not need to be the same length, as you can see from this sample.






2. Center the first piece of 1/16" ribbon and poke onto tacks as shown. This piece will tie around the middle of the bow to hold it secure. You can make this piece any length you desire. If you want a handle that secures at the underside of a hatbox, then you will want to make the piece long enough to that end.

3. Next take the end of your ribbon spool and poke onto the left tack as shown.

4. Take the ribbon and create a figure "8" pattern on the two nails. Three loops per side is the size this tutorial uses.

5. When you are done making figure "8s", secure the tail end of the ribbon by poking it on the right side's tack.

6. Next, slip the first ribbon from it's tacks, and tie a tight knot at the center point of the bow. The bow is now complete and you can remove it from the other two tacks. Slide the bow from the nail shafts.

Toiletries

NOTE: The perfume box no longer has the recessed opening.

Powder Box

1. Fold the box's 8 panels and the lid's 8 panels.
2. Use a straight-edge ruler to fold the tab line on both the box and lid.
3. Glue side tabs found on both lid and box.
4. Glue lid's top disk onto tabs and glue bottom disk onto tabs.

Powder Puff and Perfume

1. Follow the photos for assembling bottle and puff.
2. You may want to use a plastic cement type glue for the perfume bottle.
3. Glue bead or pearl to smallest pom pom.
3. Cut pins with wire cutters if necessary, so it is the length of the bead "stopper", bead perfume "bottle" and, bead spacer "bottle foot". Be careful not to let cut end fly.
4. Glue all pieces in place and allow to dry in a safe spot.




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
Shoe Box, Glove Box, and Lingerie Box

Note: Lingerie box bottom does not have lining panels by design.


1. Cut and fold pieces.



2. Glue corner tabs



3. Secure Tabs with tweezers.



4. Paint glue to interfacing panels and fold inward. Press tightly with tweezers.

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Corsage Box:

1. Glue tips of the triangle panels.



2. You may make the hook slices, but the easiest closure is to glue the front and back tips together.



Paddle Fan

1. Cut rectangles and fold in half.



2. Glue blank sides together



3. Snip around perimeter of fan panel.



4. Paint toothpicks with craft paint, if desired. That's Crayola clay used to hold stick things.



5. Cut tooth picks to desired length.




6. Glue one tooth pick to bottom of fan panel (small end up).



7. Glue second tooth pick to reverse side.

Ornament Platform:

1. Cut tabs and long strips.
2. Fold tabs carefully on both disks. You want to keep the tabs folded so the line is even around the circle. Disks should sit flat on table.
3. Paint glue to a few tabs at a time. Press the tabs against the second disk's tabs.
4. Keep the disks flat on the table. Otherwise, you will have a wobbly platform.
5. Take the finishing strips and glue them around the platform. Again, keep the platform flat on the table.
6. Continue the second strip on the 100mm platform.
7. Finished platform.



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FYI: Border design around platform is now a strip like in the tutorial.
