


bookss1 Contemporary Collection Breakfast Glory



Required tools and supplies:

- X-acto knife and fresh blade. Projects can be cut with scissors if you prefer.
- A thin metal straightedge ruler can be used to make fold lines by pressing against edge of the ruler.
- Tweezers are good for holding and pressing glue bonds.
- A cotton swab is also a useful tool for pressing glue bonds.
- Use a good cutting mat. Cardboard used as a substitute cutting mat will ruin your blade and your project will have rough edges.
- The best glue to use is a fast-grab, quick-dry, white craft glue that dries clear. Regular craft glue is too soupy to be of help here.
- An acid-free glue stick comes in handy, but only use when specified.
- A small piece of aluminum foil makes a good disposable glue pot.
- A slender artist's paintbrush is a good tool to use to apply glue. Wash the brush in clear water when not in use. Some prefer to use a toothpick, but a brush will give you much more control.



Egg Carton Assembly


1. Fold as indicated above including tabs.
2. Glue latch panel on lid to inside of matching lid latch panel.
3. Glue corner tabs to form clam shell box shape.
4. Glue inside lid panel to inside of lid.
5. Pick the Inside base panel and glue to inside of base.
6. Cut slits half way distance of egg dividers.
7. Lock dividers together via slits and place inside carton.
8. Make Fimo eggs if desired.

Coffee Bag

1. Fold at orange lines.
2. Make flat seam in back.
3. Look at photo for sealing top and bottom.
4. For a more realistic shiny look, spray or paint when assembled with polyurethane (clear coat paint).

English Muffin Box Assembly

1. Fold sides upward on main box.
2. Glue white corner tabs to inside of box.
3. Fold sides downward of false muffins panel.
4. Place false muffins into box
5. Bag. Cut rectangle from kitchen plastic wrap.
6. Cut notches at end.
7. Place muffin box face down on plastic as indicated.
8. Glue side of bag and glue notched end closed
9. Use thin wire to twist other end of bag shut.



Milk and Juice Carton Assembly

1. Cut and fold carton as shown here. The milk carton is assembled in the same manner.
2. Glue the side tab and press bond using tweezers as shown here.
3. Glue the four tabs found on the bottom of the carton. Allow all glue to dry thoroughly before proceeding to the next step.
4. Position the inner panels as shown here in the photo. Place a layer of glue to the inner blank surface of the strip that has the word "OPEN" printed on it.
5. Press the glue to the opposite panel and glue tight with help from the tweezers. The inner panels will stay in place. Hold until the glue has pretty much dried. The carton is complete.
6. You can have an open spout. Instead of step 4. above, position the inner panel outward. After finishing step 5., patiently glue the two cut edges to the carton as shown here. For your information, the sides of the spout need to be cut or the assembly won't work...as illogical as it might seem.

Popcorn Chicken: Fold at all 4 panels.
Glue side tab to blank inside surface of last panel.
Fold base tabs and glue into place.
Tuck down opening tabs and tuck in lid.

Grilled Chicken Box: Fold 4 panels to create box shape.
Fold top panel downward—the entire length of box.
Form-fold the 2 lines that are the top of the triangular shape.
Glue side tab to blank side of final box panel.
Fold base's tabs upward and glue in place.

Gossip Magazines Faux Pages:
Cut out pages.
Glue pages to each other. Make sure stack is lined up perfectly
Glue to inside of magazine.

BBQ Sauce Boxes: Glue BBQ printed panel onto white box.

SODA CAN ASSEMBLY:

1. Cut out parts.
2. Use a pencil or dowel to roll strip.
3. Glue side of can at edge of printing.
4. Glue top and bottom in place.

GRILLED CHICKEN BOX ASSEMBLY:

1. Fold 4 panels to create box shape.
2. Fold base tabs upward.
3. Fold top panel downward--the entire length of box.
4. Form-fold the 2 lines that are the top of the triangular lines.
5. Glue side tab to blank side of final box panel.
6. Fold up base tabs and glue in place.

FRY POCKET ASSEMBLY:

1. Fold all 4 butterfly tabs and base.
2. Glue blank butterfly tabs to underside of "Caution" tabs.

FOOD BAG ASSEMBLY:

1. Fold at all seams
2. Glue side tab.
3. Glue bottom flaps flat.

KETCHUP PACKETS ASSEMBLY:

1. Fold at base.
2. Glue very close to the inside edge of both long sides.
3. Stuff with a little tissue and glue top closed.

POPCORN CHICKEN BOX ASSEMBLY:

1. Fold at all 4 panels.
2. Glue side tab to blank inside surface of last panel.
3. Fold base tabs and glue into place.
4. Tuck down opening tabs and tuck in lid.

CUP AND CHICK BUCKET ASSEMBLY:

1. The assembly is the same for both. Cut out pieces and roll cups and bucket around pencil or dowel to get a primary, even curve.
2. Carefully fold upward the tabs at the base. Make sure that the fold is the same on each so that when the base is adhered there will not be bumps.
3. Glue side tab to blank inner opposite side.
4. Fit inner disk inside and glue in place. This step ensures the bucket will be round in shape.
5. Glue second disk to the outside bottom.

TV GUIDE PAGES ASSEMBLY:

1. Cut out the two panels.
2. Glue tab to blank side of 2nd panel of page.
3. Accordion fold pages.
4. Glue pages back-to-back, but glue 1st and last pages as marked to inside of front and back covers.



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
