

# The Vintage Toy Shop, Vol. 7 Assembly Instructions for Vintage Board Game Boxes (1:12 scale)




## Required tools and supplies:

- X-acto knife and fresh blade and detailing scissors
- A thin metal straight-edge ruler. Make fold lines by pressing against edge of the ruler.
- Tweezers and scissor
- Good cutting mat (cardboard will ruin your blades and project)
- Fast-grab, quick-dry white craft glue that dries clear
- Small piece of aluminum foil to use as a glue pot
- Slender, flat artist's paint brush to apply glue



1. Cut pieces. Then fold as indicated in photo against a metal-edge ruler to get the best creases possible.



2. Paint glue to each tab found at corners.



3. Use tweezers to press tabs to respective sides.



4. I found glueing long tabs to outside of the bottom panel easiest for me and then I pressed evenly against the cutting mat to get a flat bottom. You may prefer to glue bottom on top of long tabs.



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
